Tim Geiger **President and Co-Founder**

Tim Geiger is co-founder and president of Tetra Point Fuels LLC, headquartered in Denton, Texas. Geiger formed the privately held company in June 2007 with Chris Ball, an industrial technology specialist, long-time business partner and childhood friend. Tetra Point is a national ethanol manufacturer and waste management provider. The company's innovative approach to ethanol manufacturing allows it to transform existing commercial waste (liquids and solids) into ethanol while also recycling the majority of left-over raw materials. The company offers Completely Friendly Fuel™—alternative, eco-friendly biofuels—plus recyclable materials such as aluminum, plastics and glass to a variety of commercial, consumer and industrial buyers.

Geiger is responsible for overall business continuity and activities, including strategic planning, finances, operations, business development and supplier relations. Prior to forming Tetra Point, Geiger spent 25 years in aerospace, national defense and industrial manufacturing, mostly in Virginia. His core competencies—business operations and complex project management—matched with a long work history serving federal government agencies guided his decision to form Tetra Point. Geiger received his bachelor's of science degree in air transportation management from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University in Daytona Beach, Fla. His strengths: Managing large, complex design and integration projects, site installation planning, resource scheduling and cost tracking and risk management.

In late 2006, Geiger began to evaluate business opportunities and researched the growing demand for “alternative” energy sources. That's when he and Chris Ball researched ethanol as the energy source for the world. Within six months, they had formed the basis of Tetra Point's competitive advantage—an organic, planet-friendly, chemically sound manufacturing process that created ethanol without hurting global corn supplies, demands or pricing.

Geiger and his team decided on Denton, Texas, as Tetra Point's first manufacturing facility, thanks to city and county support, and close proximity to suppliers and academic centers of excellence such as the University of North Texas. When he's not at Tetra Point, Geiger is camping and hiking with his wife and three children, or going to air shows to watch the Blue Angels.
